**Outlaw Speedway**  
**Bandit Rules**

**For all participants safety, it is recommended that all drivers and car owners read and understand the Safety, General, and all 4cyl class rules before participating in this division.**

- 1** - All vehicles must weigh 2450lbs with driver, after race
- 2** - All Drivers must be at least 12 years of age, and have a parental consent form signed by both parents, or legal guardians
- 3** - All parents/guardians must provide a copy of the drivers birth certificate, to be held on file at the Outlaw Speedway office
- 4** - Driver may race until his/her 16<sup>th</sup> birthday, at which point they may choose to finish out the current season, or move up to a different division
- 5** - Any driver found in lineup without required safety equipment (see general rules), will not be let onto the race track
- 6** - Any Bandit driver who competes in an adult division of any kind will lose all points and will no longer be eligible to compete in the Bandit class at Outlaw Speedway
- 7** - A single car may be used to compete in both the Bandit and Mini Stock classes (different drivers)
- 8** - All safety, general, and cage requirements will be the same as 4cyl Mini Stock rules
